



CERTIFICATE IN ADVANCED ENGLISH (CAE)

Content and overview

Reading (75min) Part 1 consists of three short texts on a theme. There are two four multiple-choice questions on each text. Part 2. One long text from which six paragraphs have been removed and placed in jumbled order after the text. 3. There are seven four multiple-choice questions which follow the order of one long text and test range of reading and language skills. 4. One long text which is preceded by 15 prompts which report information and ideas from the text.

Writing (90 min): 1. Candidates read around 150 words of input information, which may come from various real-world texts and use this information to complete a structured writing task for 180-220 words. 2. Candidates select one situationally based task from a choice of five which may include: article, competition entry ...

Use of English (60 min): 1. This task features from which 12 words or phrases have been removed, which is followed by 12 four-option multiple-choice questions (vocabulary and the relationships between words.) 2. Open cloze which 15 words have been removed. 3. This task features a text from which ten words have been removed. The base form of each missing word is given as a prompt. Candidates must use their knowledge of grammar and word building to insert the correct form of the given word.

Listening (40 min): Part 1 consists of three short independent listening texts. There are 2 three-option multiple-choice questions on each text which test a range of listening skills. Part 2 consists of a monologue lasting approximately three minutes. Candidates listen and complete the missing information. Part 3 consists of an interview or discussion lasting three or four minutes, with 6 four-option multiple-choice questions.

Speaking (15 min): 1. the interlocutor asks the candidates questions about themselves. The focus is on general interactional and social language. 2. In this part, each candidate has a long turn lasting approximately one minute to talk about a different set of photographs. 3. Two-way conversation.
